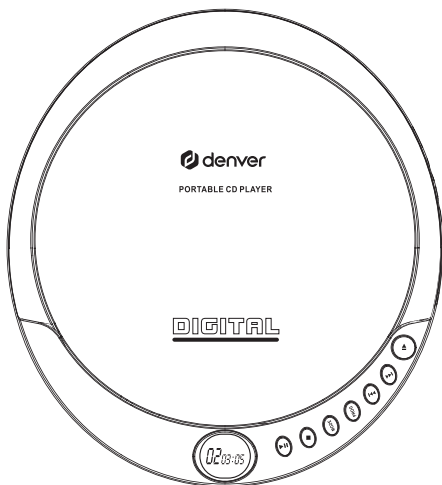

Instruction Manual

Safety information

Please read the safety instructions carefully before using the product for the first time and keep the instructions for future reference.

1. This product is not a toy. Keep it out of reach of children.
2. Keep product out of the reach of children and pets to avoid chewing and swallowing.
3. Product operating and storage temperature is from 0 degree Celsius to 40 degree Celsius. Under and over this temperature might affect the function.
4. Never open the product. Touching the inside electrics can cause electric shock. Repairs or service should only be performed by qualified personnel.
5. Do not expose to heat, water, moisture, direct sunlight!
6. The unit is not waterproof. If water or foreign objects enter the unit, it may result in fire or electric shock. If water or a foreign object enters the unit, stop use immediately.
7. Do not use non original accessories together with the product as this can make the product functionality abnormal.

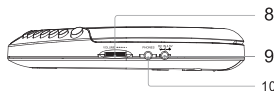
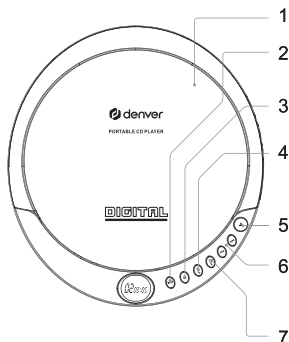

Introduction

(English)

Portable Compact CD Player

- 1 **CD DOOR**
- 2 **PLAY/PAUSE**
Press to play or pause a loaded CD.
- 3 **STOP/OFF**
Press to stop a CD during play. In stop mode, press to power off the CD player.
- 4 **MODE**
Press to repeat a single track or an entire CD, play tracks in a random order, or play the CD in intro mode.
- 5 **OPEN**
Press to open the CD DOOR.
- 6 **SKIP/SEARCH**
Press to skip between tracks on a loaded CD. Press and hold to search an individual track on a loaded CD.
- 7 **PROG**
Press to program a loaded CD to play tracks in a specified order.
- 8 **VOLUME**
Press to adjust the volume.
- 9 **DC POWER INPUT**
- 10 **STEREO EARPHONE JACK**

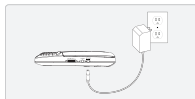

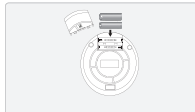
Power

Requires an AC/DC power adapter (not included).
Input: 230V/50Hz
Output: DC5V, 1000mA

Operations

Loading a CD

1. Press the **OPEN** button to open the CD DOOR.
2. Load a CD into the player, label side up.
3. Close the CD DOOR.

Playing a CD

1. Follow the instructions for [Loading a CD](#).
2. Press the **PLAY/PAUSE** button to begin playing the loaded CD.

Programming a CD

1. Follow the instructions for [Loading a CD](#) and [Playing a CD](#).
2. Press the **STOP** button to stop the CD during play.
3. Press the **PROG** button.
"01" will begin to blink on the DISPLAY.
4. Press the **SKIP/SEARCH** buttons to select the track you wish to program.
5. Press the **PROG** button to save the selected track to the program.
6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 to program up to 20 tracks to play in the order they are programmed.
7. Press the **PLAY/PAUSE** button to begin playing the programmed tracks.
