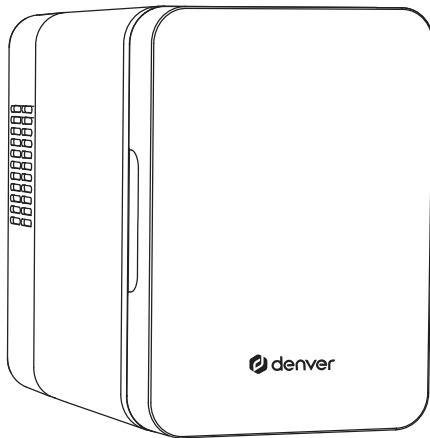

Safety instructions

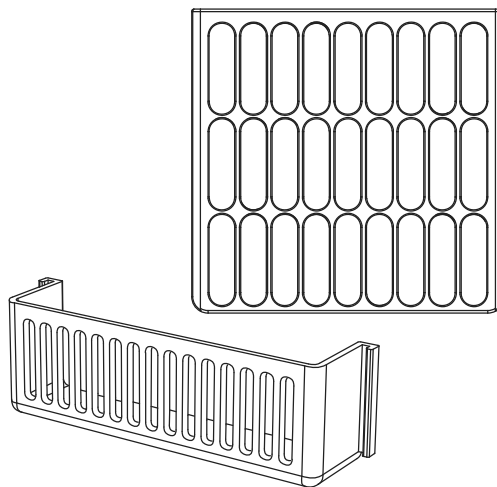
1. To protect against electrical shock, never immerse power cords, cables or plugs in water or other liquids.
2. This unit only works on 220-240V AC or 12V DC.
3. Unplug the unit from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool prior to cleaning the product.
4. When not in use for extended periods, store the device in a well-ventilated area.
5. Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after any malfunction or damage to the unit.
6. If any of the SUPPLIED CORDS are damaged, they must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or a similarly qualified person, in order to avoid a hazard.
7. Do not let the cord hang over the edge of the table counter or come into contact with a hot surface.
8. Always attach plug to the unit first, then plug power cord into the wall outlet or DC unit. To disconnect, first turn unit switch to the OFF position, then remove plug from the outlet.
9. When plugging in the unit, make sure the power cord is inserted tightly into the outlet. A loose socket can cause damage or fire.
10. The use of extension cords with this product is not recommended.
11. Keep the device away from fire or other flammable materials.
12. Do not operate under direct sunlight.
13. When alternating between WARM and COOL settings, turn the switch to the OFF position first, wait two minutes, then turn the switch to the desired setting.
14. If using in a car, disconnect the plug from the cigarette lighter when not in use or when the car is not running.
15. Allow adequate ventilation on all sides of the unit when in operation. Keep the fan free from any obstruction.
16. Do not store meat, poultry, fish, dairy products, or other items that may spoil within the device for more than an hour.

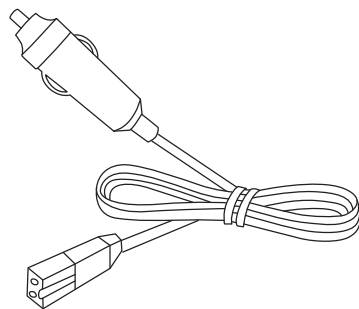

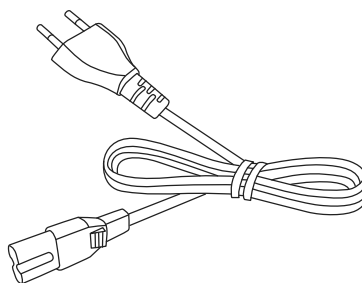
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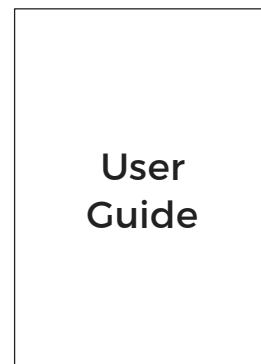
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User instructions

Household Power Connection:

Plug the Europlug end of the included AC power cable into a power socket, and the other end into the AC power port.

DC adaptor connection:

1. Plug the Car adaptor into the car and the DC end into the DC power port.
2. Cooling function: Slide the switch to the top position to start cooling, and the green indicator light will illuminate. The refrigerator will cool down to 6 Celsius (Based on room temperature on 20 Celsius or below)
3. Heating function: Slide the switch to the bottom position to start heating, and the red indicator light will illuminate. The refrigerator will now go up to 55 Celsius after a while.

Good to know

- Stopping Cooling/Stopping Heating: Slide the switch to the middle position marked with "OFF".
- Allow 1-2 hours to achieve coldest temperature based on the ambient room temperature.
- The WARM setting is not adjustable and is not intended to “heat up” contents.

Maintenance

1. Always keep the electrical wires and cigarette lighter sockets clean.
2. Contaminants such as ash particles in sockets or plugs may affect performance.
3. When cleaning, use a warm damp cloth or sponge to wipe the interior.
4. Do not use harsh or abrasive cleaners.
5. Using a mild soap is sufficient, but if stains or odors persist, you can add household bleach or baking soda to the cleaning solution.
6. Keep the lid open for a few hours after cleaning.
