Safety information

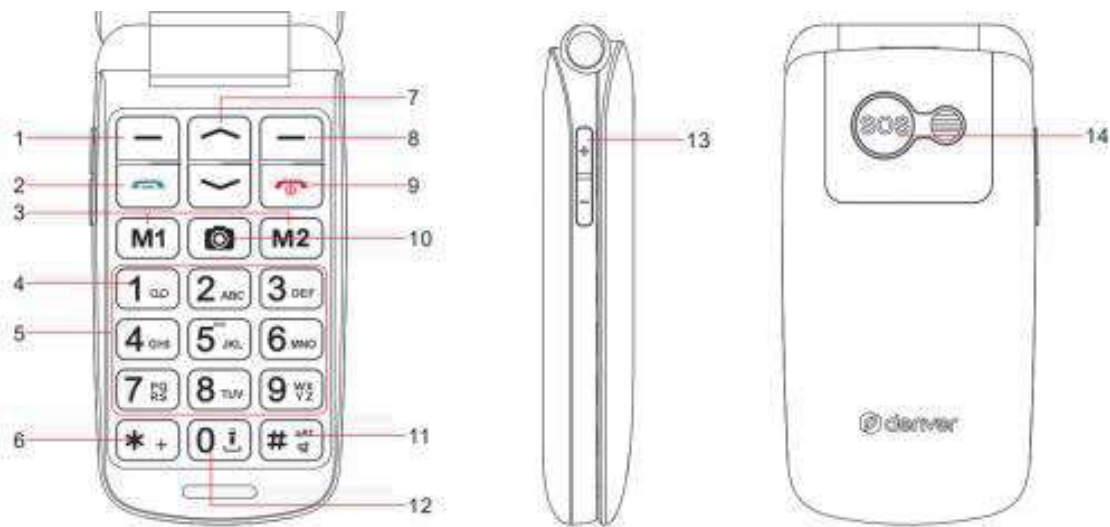
Please read the safety instructions carefully before using the product for the first time and keep the instructions for future reference.

1. Warning: This product includes a rechargeable lithium-ion battery.
2. Keep product out of the reach of children and pets to avoid chewing and swallowing.
3. The operating and storage temperature range of the product is from 0 degrees Celsius to 40 degrees Celsius. Temperatures below or above this range may affect the normal operation of the product and also impact the battery lifespan
4. Never open the product. Do not touch the inside electronics, or you may get an electric shock. Repairs or service should only be performed by qualified personnel.
5. Do not expose the device or the battery to high temperatures, water, moisture or direct sunlight! Because this will affect the normal operation of the equipment and the battery life.

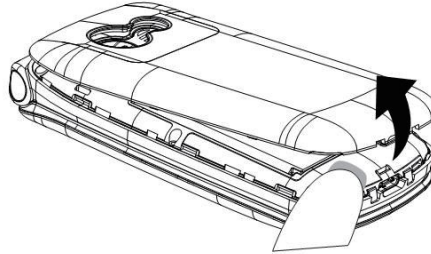
1 Overview



1. Enter submenu 1. To select the Option that is shown at the bottom left of the screen and confirm a selection.
2. Answer or start a call; in standby: press to open Call History.
3. Speed dial key-M1/M2.
4. Long press to call your voicemail.
5. Numeric and alphabetic buttons.
6. Asterisk key.
7. Up/down keys. Use the keys to navigate the menus.
8. Enter submenu 2. To select the Option that is shown at the bottom right of the screen.
9. Press and hold for power on or off; press to end a call; in menus: press to exit.
10. Camera.
11. Use the key to switch between the abc, ABC, Abc and 123 input methods.
Press and hold this key to switch between ringing and mute modes.
12. Press and hold the button to turn Flashlight on or off.
13. Volume controls.
14. Emergency button.

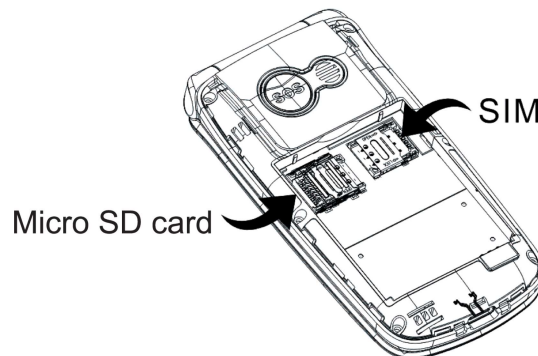
2. Setting up your phone

Remove the rear cover of the phone. Opening is in the bottom left corner. You can use your fingernail to lift off the cover.



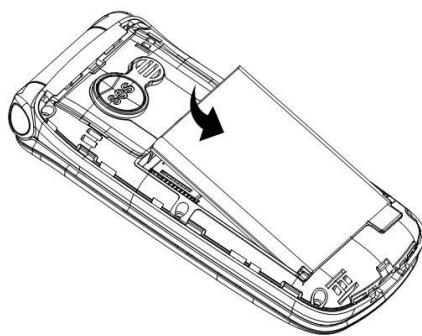
Insert the SIM card into the holder with the chip facing downwards. SIM card is not included. SIM cards and contacts are easily damaged due to scratches and bending. Please be careful.

SIM : Nano SIM



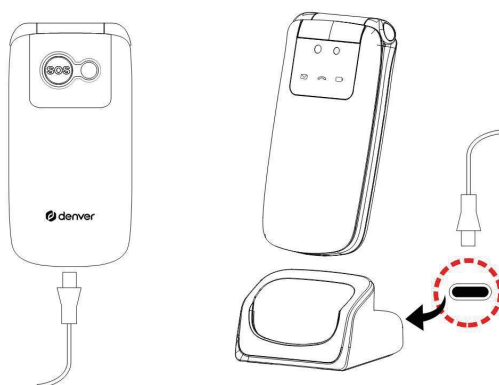
This step is optional and is only needed for storing pictures, videos or other multimedia files. Insert a microSD card (Max 32GB) into the card slot as shown below with gold contacts facing down. MicroSD card is not included.

Insert the battery into battery slot.



Put the rear cover on again. You will hear a click when mounted.

Before you start using the phone, charge the battery with a power adapter for at least 4 hours. (Power adapter not included, but USB cable and charging cradle are included.)



3.SOS settings

Read the instructions carefully and set the emergency function according to your needs. You can save up to five emergency contacts (family members, friends and official institutions).

In an emergency, press and hold the emergency button on the back of the phone. The five preset numbers will be dialed automatically in the order in which you have saved them. If it is not possible to get through to anyone on the first number, the second number will automatically be dialed. If it is not possible to get through to anyone on the second number, the third number will automatically be dialed, and so on. (The phone will go through a list of five numbers a maximum of three times.)

At the same time as each emergency call, a text message (SMS) will be sent to the contact.

During the emergency call, a warning tone will sound continuously to alert anyone nearby and the person being called.

4.Restore Factory settings

This setting reset all the settings of the phone back to Factory setting.Default password is 1234

5. Power management function

To extend the battery life,you can limit the maximum charge level to 80% by enabling below option "optimized charging"。 Settings-Phone settings- Battery optimisation,Select ON to enable the optimized charging management. The charging will stop when the battery reaches 80% capacity. Charging will only commence when the battery level drops to 75%. When you select "OFF", this function will be turned off. The battery can be charged to 100%, but charging will only start when the battery level drops to 95%. It is recommended to keep the power management function enabled for extended periods, as this can help prolong the battery's service life.

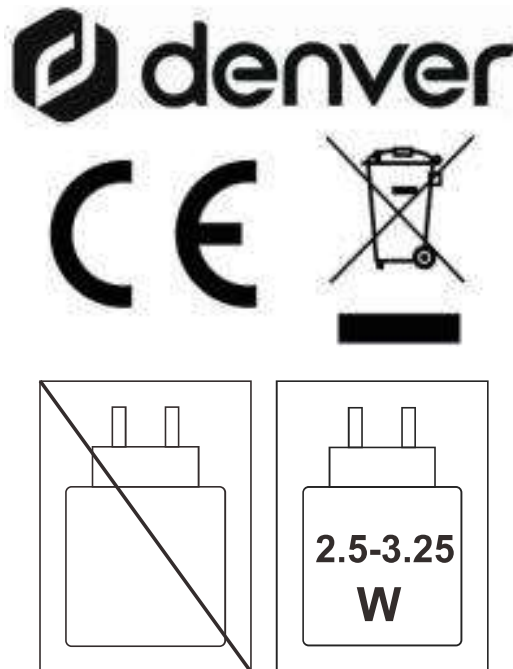
Turning off the Bluetooth function can increase the standby time by five percent. Turning off the FM function can extend battery life by 15% compared to when it is turned on.
